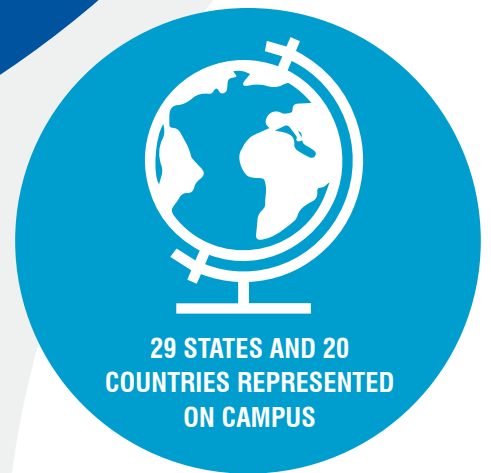

# GET READY TO BE TRUE BLUE

The application process at Illinois College is all about you. We focus not only on your academics, but on your accomplishments outside the classroom as well. This comprehensive review not only recognizes your preparation for college, but your potential merit-based scholarship as well.

## 1. APPLY FOR ADMISSION

Complete your free application at [admission.ic.edu/apply](https://admission.ic.edu/apply), [www.commonapp.org](https://www.commonapp.org), and [www.mycoalition.org](https://www.mycoalition.org).

## 2. SUBMIT YOUR TRANSCRIPT

Submit an official secondary school/high school transcript translated into English that indicates academic achievement. Official, translated college/university transcripts are required if the student is transferring from another undergraduate institution.

## 3. SUBMIT TEST SCORES

Submit a TOEFL, IELTS, CEFR, PTE, GTEC, Duolingo English Test, ACT or SAT test score.

Students whose language of educational instruction was primarily English do not need to provide a language proficiency score but are required to provide an ACT or SAT score. Illinois College will also recognize successful completion of an English language program in lieu of an English language proficiency exam.
